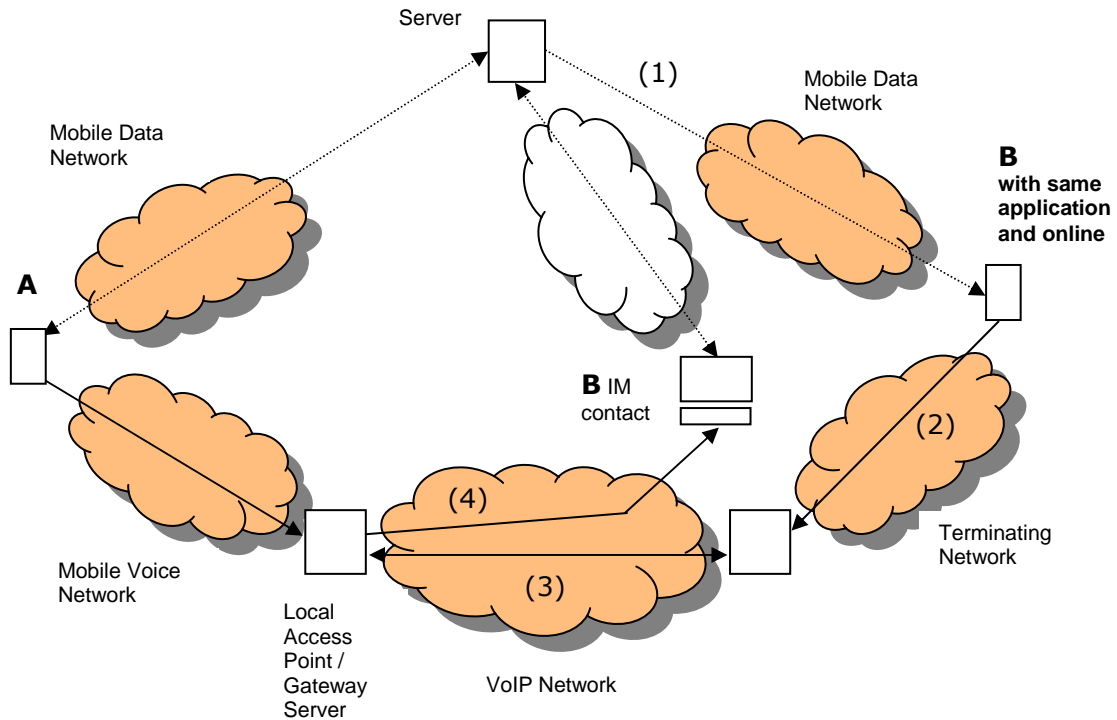


Tutorial: Call-Through System – Other Connections



If B has the same application

(1) In this case if B is using the same application as A and is online, the server also signals B that A wants to call and provides the number of the nearest local access point to B.

(2) If B accepts the call his application calls his local access point.

(3) A has made a call to his local access point and the two calls are connected over the VoIP network so A and B can talk to one another.

Both caller A and callee B use minutes for the local call each makes.

If B is an IM buddy

(4) Caller A can also call IM clients compatible with his application. The application provides presence information over the mobile data channel.
